Do I still pay a registration fee if I am a renewal student?

Yes, there is a Bi-annual registration fee for renewal students. The Bi-annual registration fee is R515 per semester. Both renewal and new students are required to pay this amount.

I have not completed my matric and I want to study at the IMM Graduate School. Is that possible?

Yes, it is possible? A CV and RPL (Recognition of Prior Learning) application is required from prospective students over 23 years of age, who do not have a National Senior Certificate (NSC), and must include work-related experience and a SAPS affidavit stating that they did not obtain a NSC. This will allow you entrance to the higher certificate programme. You can download the application form from the IMM Graduate School website (www.immgsm.ac.za).

What documents are required for registration to an undergraduate programme?

You will need to submit a copy of your original Identity Document, matric certificate.

- Print the forms available on the IMM Graduate School website in the downloads section.
- Complete the forms and post these, along with the proof of payment and certified copies of your original documentation to P O Box 91820, Auckland Park, 2006.
- The IMM Graduate School requires that all new students complete the following:
- Undergraduate Registration Form [for the Higher Certificates, Diplomas and Degrees];
- Or the Postgraduate Registration Form [for the Postgraduate Diploma, Honours or Masters].
- The Examination Declaration Form must accompany all registration.

Can I get a degree from the IMM Graduate School?

Absolutely, provided you meet the minimum admission criteria upon registration. If you don't, then you can start by doing our Higher Certificate for a year, obtain a 60% aggregate on the 7 modules in the Higher Certificate, and then you can articulate from the Higher Certificate onto a degree programme. You can obtain either a BBA Degree or a BCom Degree with us.

How long will it take me to complete a degree at the IMM Graduate School?

A degree at the IMM can be completed in a minimum of 3 years, and a maximum of 8 years. The duration will also be determined by the number of modules you are able to register for in a semester. The less modules you take per semester, the longer it will take you to complete your qualification. Students are allowed to take a minimum of one module and a maximum of four modules per semester.

ONLINE SHORT COURSES

What is the definition of short course?

Do I have to write an examination to complete the online short course?

No, you do not need to write an examination to complete the short course. You will however be required to complete either an assignment, or assessment to illustrate your grasp and understanding of the course content. It is required for you to achieve a 50% pass rate in order for your submission to be viewed as successful. Upon completion of your online short course and you successfully passing the assessment or assignment you will be issued with a Certificate of Completion.

What does the certificate say?

Your Certificate of Completion will include the name of the institution (IMM Graduate School), your name and ID Number, the full name and ID of the online short course, date of issue and where applicable, signatures of delegated officials. Where the online short course is being offered in conjunction with one of our partners, their branding will also appear on the certificate.

What are cookies and does the IMM Graduate School make use of these on its website?

Cookies are small files which are stored on a user's computer. They are designed to hold a modest amount of data specific to a particular client and website, and can be accessed either by the web server or the client computer. This allows the server to deliver a page tailored to a particular user, or the page itself can contain some script which is aware of the data in the cookie and so is able to carry information from one visit to the website (or related site) to the next.

What happens if I don't pass my assignment?

Due to the nature of an online short course, no exam will be written. As such, it's very important that your assignment meets the minimum pass rate. There is unfortunately no opportunity to resubmit your assignment should you not meet the minimum pass rate and you will receive a letter of attendance instead of a certificate of successful completion.
